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Definitive Map and Statement Modification
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This Order is made by The East Riding of Yorkshire Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ('the Act') because it appears to that authority that the Humberside County Council Borough of East Yorkshire Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act, namely the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a byway open to all traffic.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The East Riding of Yorkshire Council hereby orders that:

- 1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 1 July 2016.
- 2. The Humberside County Council Borough of East Yorkshire Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way shall be modified as described in Part I and II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
- 3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The East Riding of Yorkshire Council (Rudston No. 10, Boynton No. 5 and Grindale No. 1) Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2016.


Description of path or way to be added

A Byway Open to All Traffic commencing in the parish of Grindale on Boynton Lane to the north of Fox Covert Plantation at Grid Reference TA 1305 7052 (Point A on the Map) and leading west-north-westerly along Fox Covert Lane for some 705 metres to the end of the lane at Grid Reference TA 1235 7063 (Point B on the Map) then west-south-westerly through Fox Covert Plantation for some 105 metres to Grid Reference TA 1226 7057 (Point C on the Map) then south-westerly on the south side of the field boundary for some 985 metres to join the eastern end of High Caythorpe Lane at High Caythorpe Farm at Grid Reference TA 1151 6994 (point D on the Map).

Width

A-B to be recorded with a width of 9 metres and a useable width of 5 metres.

B-C-D to be recorded with a width of 5 metres.
